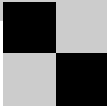

Program Description

Subsurface drainage is an important part of agricultural systems in Iowa. To function most efficiently, all components of a subsurface drainage system should be designed to work together for optimum efficiency. This program will provide information essential for designing and planning a new drainage system or retrofitting an existing system. In addition, the economic and long-term benefits of tiling will be discussed along with some of the legal issues related to subsurface drainage. While the economic benefits of tiling are well recognized, there are also environmental impacts from drainage. New technologies that may be useful in minimizing negative environmental impacts will be discussed.
